Writing: Essential Question: We are focusing on writing informative pieces. Our goal is at least 3 sentences.

Reading: We are finding the comparisons between familiar characters in stories. Mrs. Fay has an "aliens vs. astronauts" theme happening. The students are building their own rockets along with book buddies.

Math: We are comparing attributes of objects by using vocabulary such as: longer than, shorter than, heavier than, lighter than. We'll be learning to measure from a common starting point.

Science: What is living and what is non-living? How do you know? What does a living thing need?

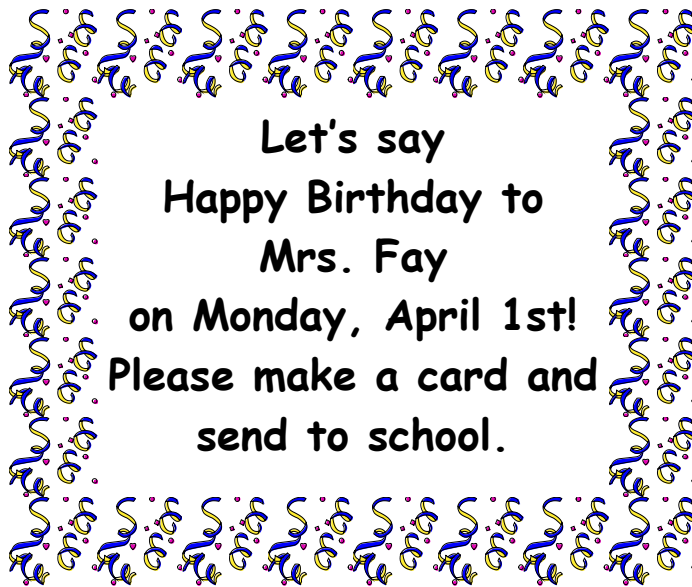


Things to do at home:

Work on sight word fluency. Practice how many sight words your child can read in one minute. Make it a fun challenge by being encouraging and set a larger goal each time. If your child reads 22 then make your new goal 25 in one minute.
