Writing: We're currently writing a report about animals in the computer lab using Kidspiration. We began by researching the animal on the PebbleGo website. Then we used a graphic organizer to write 4 things about our animal.

Reading: We are learning about the 'ing' and 'ed' endings of words.

Math: We revisiting fact families up to 5 for the next two weeks.

Science: What are the differences/similarities between types of animals? Mammals, birds, fish, amphibians, reptiles. We'll be looking at habitat, how their young are born, what they eat, etc. On Wednesday we will plant seeds with our book buddies.



Things to do at home:

Work on sight word fluency. Practice how many sight words your child can read in one minute. Make it a fun challenge by being encouraging and set a larger goal each time. If your child reads 22 then make your new goal 25 in one minute.

Practice counting to 100 by 5s and 10s this week.

Explore all the ways to make the numbers 3, 4, and 5. For example:

3 red crayons + 0 other colors = 3 crayons.

1 yellow crayon + 2 red crayons = 3 crayons.

2 yellow crayons + 1 red crayons = 3 crayons.
