Writing: We've shared oral stories, Brag Bags, and heart maps. This week we will set up our writing journals and write for our first writing sample.

Reading: Benchmark testing took two days of our reading time so THIS WEEK we begin the Daily 5. We reviewed I PICK:

- I—I Choose a Book
- P—Purpose—Why am I reading the book? (Pleasure or to learn something)
- I—Interest (does it interest me?)
- C—Comprehend—Do I understand what I'm reading?

Math: We learned a new game this week—My Place on the Number Line. We are adding/subtracting numbers up and down a 100—place number line. We've been reviewing adding 10s to any row moves us down one column.

Social Studies: We begin our unit on Georgia by learning about the regions of Georgia this week.
