Grammar: Types of sentences and punctuation marks.

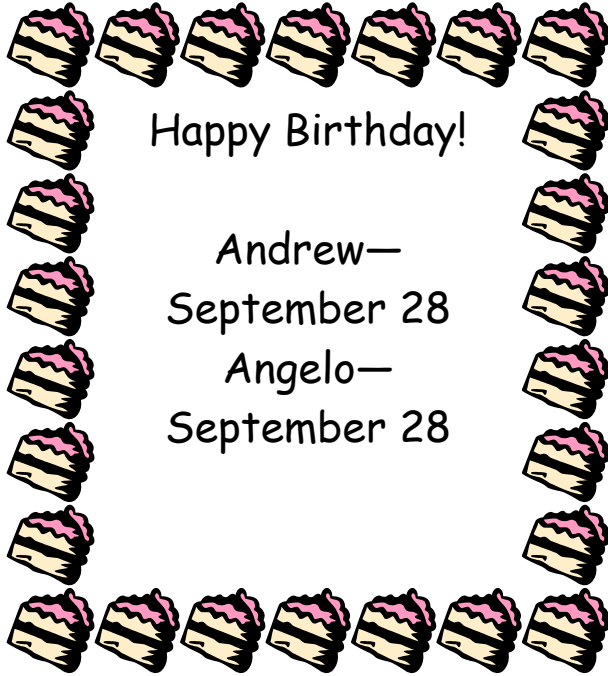
