Writing: Essential Question: What is a small moment? We are writing stories that focus on one event and trying to narrow the topic.

Reading: Essential Question: Why do we write? We've added writing to our Daily 5. We'll be focusing on writing numbers next week.

Math: Essential Question: How do I create a pattern? How do I extend a pattern?

Social Studies: Essential Questions: What is a community helper? We'll continue learning about people's jobs (including our parents).



Things to do at home:

Segment words into syllables and count them. Then practice saying syllables and have your child put them together and say the word.

Practice making patterns. We'll explore AB, AAB, AAB, AABB so start patterning with anything as simple as forks/spoons/knives, food, Legos, etc. Watch for patterns in nature, clothes, animals.
