Writing: Essential Question: What is research? How do I write facts? We are continuing to read difference sources of material to write facts about animals (bats) and Pilgrims. I am looking for three facts and a reaction to what they've read.

Reading: We are comparing the similarities and differences between non-fiction texts about the same subject by looking at illustrations and descriptions and structure.

Math: We are focusing on identifying the next number that comes in a sequence of numbers.

Social Studies: Essential Questions: Who were the pilgrims? What is Thanksgiving?

I will not be sending homework folders this week. Star Cards will be in your child's book bags on Monday since I had to leave early Friday.



Things to do at home:

Practice counting out loud from a specific number. Begin counting numbers between 1-20. For example: say 7 and then count out loud to 20.

Choose nonfiction books to read. Discuss what a caption means and that important words and ideas are in bold letters, for example. The table of contents is a quick way to get an idea of what is covered in the book and how to get to that page quickly.

Point out the white space between words to show they are separate from one another.
