Writing: Essential Question: How do I tell a small moment? We are practicing how to write small moment story again.

Reading: We are reading Gingerbread Man books to find the main topic and then filling in the important details.

Math: We are counting objects and discussing if they are less than, equal to or greater than 10.



Things to do at home:

Practice writing stories. Talk about the story and then draw a picture. After that decide on what happened first, what happened next and what happened at the end.

Math: Practice these:

- Writing numbers 1-20
- Counting by 5s to 100
- Counting by 10s to 100
- Counting “teen” numbers
- Counting across the decades. Examples: 19...20; 29...30; 39...40. Ask what number will come next when you say 49.
